The plans include development on the fields along Longbottom Lane; fields both sides of the M40 spur; the fields along the A40 between the Old Town and up to Holtspur, among others. The Beaconsfield Society are holding a Public Meeting on Thursday 28th November at 8:00pm at St. Mary's Church in the Old Town.
