## School Travel Plan – Promotion Jan 2022

## Aim

Encourage walking, scootering, and cycling to and from School to increase health benefits, reduce the number of car journeys, and enhance environmental benefits in and around the School and in Beaconsfield.

## What we do?

We develop and promote:

- Our School Travel Plan (STP) to pupils via the Junior Road Safety Officers (JRSOs).
- We submit an Annual Progress Report to Bucks Council and review regularly with the Board of Governors and School Management.
- A cycle and scooter policy and procedures for in and around the School including safety and storage to encourage participation Road safety awareness
- A considerate and safe parking policy for parents and carers when driving and parking close to the School.
- A 'Park and Stride' scheme to assist those parents/carers who are travelling from further afield and need to drive
- Links with local networks. We work with local organisations, including the Town Council and the Beaconfield Society, to promote cycling and walking networks in and around the town and influence policy particularly around proper and safe access along main routes into and the immediate environs of the school.

And manage the:

• School Crossing Patroller both at Junior House and Upper House during the morning drop off.

## How we do it?

School Crossing Patroller

- We organise daily morning provision at drop off at Junior School and Upper School
- Cycling
  - Bikeability courses at school to promote cycling and road awareness for pupils. Level 1 for YR3/YR4 and Level 2 for YR5/YR6 in the summer term
  - Promote cycling to school through 'Bike to School' week in the summer term
  - Bike tagging?
  - Bike maintenance?
- Scootering
  - Run scooter courses at school during the summer term
  - Organise School 'Scootering Days'
- Walking
  - Promote walking to school through 'Walk to School' week in the Autumn term.
  - Promote safety during 'Road Safety Awareness week' with courses for YR1/YR2.
  - Footsteps Road Safety Training for YR 2.
- Park/Stride
  - Promote parking away from the School at St Michael's Church car park or from Waitrose car park and walking the remainder along a safe route.
