Nursery

Summer Term 2022

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Developing:

- Independence – changing shoes and clothes.
- Helping others with buttons, etc.
- Turn taking.
- Respecting other children's feelings and points of view.

Communication and Language

Developing:

- Listening skills – awareness of others.
- Stories.
- Confidence in speaking to whole class.
- Phonic work. The linking of sounds to letters, naming and sounding letters of the alphabet.

Physical Development

Developing:

- Gross motor skills – climbing, jumping, running, hopping, balancing.
- Fine motor skills – pencil and brush grip.
- Buttons.
- Team games.
- Sports Day preparation.

Literacy

Developing:

- Hearing and saying the initial sounds in words.
- Reading words and simple sentences.
- Using books and computers to obtain knowledge.

Mathematics

Developing:

- Review 1 – 5, then work through numbers 6 – 10, practical and number book.
- Ordering objects by shape, size, length and weight.
- Sorting objects using one, two, three categories.
- Subitising using 10 Frames.

Understanding the World

Developing:

- Caring for our seeds, potatoes and plants in order that they grow.
- Life in the garden.
- Dinosaurs- extinction, volcanoes etc.
- Holiday destinations.

Expressive Arts and Design

Developing:

- Drawing, painting, modelling.
- Music – rhythm and patterns, reacting to different music.
- Imaginative play.
- Small world play.
- Clay work.

Music

Developing

- Pitch and rhythmic memory.
- Understanding beats and rhythms.
- Recognising musical timbres.
- Imitating sounds.
- Breathing techniques.
- Preparation for Nursery Concert.
